We are Corey and Bethany Courtwright, and we established and run the Lasting Harvest International non-profit organization. We are a Christian organization that exists to glorify God and people through Christian community development. We work with the Ngobe Indians to teach them better agriculture methods, specifically fish farming, to help support their families, build up Christian communities, and evangelize the lost. Our goal is to show them the love of Christ both in Word and deed.

Our ministry provides training courses/ education in aquaculture (fish farming), small animal projects, and some agronomy. We work mostly with the Ngobe Indians and other ministries interested in receiving training in Christian community development, but we are beginning to branch out in a new program to train college students and missionary recruits.

We host both adult and youth mission teams from the US and abroad for 7-10 day trips, as well as, Ngobe Indians for training seminars on our demonstration farm in Camaron Arriba. We always need skilled and non-skilled labor working on the demonstration farm helping to develop agricultural projects, general up keep of the farm, and dorm construction. Electricians and workers to do dry wall are greatly needed.

Our prayer is that God will use this farm to impact people on an international level. We pray that a few Ngobe families in remote areas of Western Panama to come to know the Lord and be better equipped to fight malnutrition that is so rampant in their lives, and this is a goal worth working a lifetime for. The potential to change lives across the world through equipping missionaries and Bible college students is a goal almost too staggering to imagine.
