

What to Expect:

Small groups are central to the vision of Boquete Bible Fellowship to make true disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ and carry out the Great Commission. We establish small groups to carry out this mission in a way that facilitates our participants truly doing life with one another. While we strongly believe in the importance of the local church gathering weekly, we believe belonging to a small group is essential to the growth of any Christian.

When you join a small group here at BBF, you are given a unique opportunity to walk through life with other believers that is difficult to create outside of something like a small group. We gather weekly in the homes of our members to fellowship, and our small group leader facilitates Bible study and discussion. We typically study and progress through one book of the Bible at a time in a very open manner that does not require previous or perfect attendance to participate. In this setting, we are able to explore, study, and discuss concepts and application on a personal level that is not achievable elsewhere. In participating in our small groups, you will learn how to pray, and also how to approach and study the Word of God. Our small groups are home to some of the most hospitable people in Boquete, and you will feel like family in no time!
